Soft and Fruity

1. SANTA HELENA MERLOT **2.50 3.30 4.50** 12.95
Central Valley, Chile (13.5%, C)
Soft, ripe and packed with plummy spice and red fruit flavours.

2. NUVIANA TEMPRANILLO 14.95
Valle del Cinca, Spain (13%, C)
A wine which is single-handedly shining a light on its quiet corner of Aragon. It has an 'ooh' factor of soft ripe fruit at the very first sniff.

Warm & Mellow

3. CABERNET SAUVIGNON
Puente Del Inca, Chile (13%, C) **2.50 3.30 4.50** 12.95
Super deep blackcurrant-style Cabernet, with great flavours leaping out of the glass.

4. BENCHMARK SHIRAZ
Grant Burge, Australia (14.5%, D) **3.80 4.95 5.95** 16.95
Rich aromas of pepper, dark berries and spice, with a smooth finish as long as a tiger's tail.

5. MAZUELO RIOJA CRIANZA
Azabache, Spain (13.5%, C) 19.50
Attractive combination of strawberry fruit and soft oak flavours

6. DE BORTOLI PINOT NOIR Vat 10
Australia (13.5%, C) 18.95
Intensely concentrated with strawberry and spice flavours with lovely, silky tannins and deliciously ripe fruit. An outstanding Pinot Noir.

7. CHÂTEAU PIERRAIL
Bordeaux Supérieur, France (14.0%, C) 23.95
Smoky dark wine. Carries a forest signature of wild berries and sweetly charred timber.

Sumptuous and Full-Bodied

8. THE BLACK LABEL **3.60 4.60 5.80** 16.50
McGuigan Brothers, Australia (13%, C)
Bright red, cheerful juicy aroma, soft sweet fruit and plenty of vitality all through.

9. STONY BROOK CAMISSA 19.95
Stellenbosch, South Africa (14.5%, D)
Sleek and luscious, this is a classic Cabernet/Merlot mix lifted to another level with 10% of Shiraz adding to its dazzle.

10. CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE 32.95
Chateau des Fines Roches, Rhône (14.0%, D)
The red with everything: deep dark colour; intensely spicy yet floral nose, mouthful of unctuous fruit, citrus zest, spice and candied peel. It finally folds into a velvet finish.

11. BAROLO REVELLO 31.95
Araldica, Piemonte, Italy (14%, D)
The Nebbiolo's classic hints of tar and roses seem to be tucked in here. The roses are the top notes on the dark fruits, spice and orange peel, tar gives the trademark final bite.

12. SANTA HELENA SAUVIGNON BLANC
Central Valley, Chile (13.0%, 2) **2.50 3.30 4.50** 12.95
Lively and lifted with an herbal green leafiness and real freshness

13. TOTARA HILL SAUVIGNON BLANC
Marlborough, NZ (13%, 1) 19.95
Crisp with ripe tropical notes, and a touch of cut grass

14. PETIT CHABLIS 23.95
Domaine Laroche, Burgundy (12.5%, 1)
Pale lemon-green, full rounded aroma and flavour with great finish.

15. BACCHUS
Camel Valley Vineyard, Cornwall (12.5%, 1) 23.95
Light, floral and delicate with apple blossom and a racy edge. A really vibrant dry wine that shows the potential of our Cornish Vineyards. SEASONALLY AVAILABLE

Aromatic and Fruity

16. CHARDONNAY **2.50 3.30 4.50** 12.95
Puente Del Inca, Chile (13.5%, 2)
Firm, rounded, good clean modern Chilean Chardonnay.

17. PINOT GRIGIO **2.80 3.95 4.95** 13.95
San Antonio, Umbria, Italy (12.0%, 2)
Light and leafy with a hint of pear and blossom. An easygoing match for almost anything.

18. VIOGNIER 16.95
Domaine de Montaubéron, France (13%, 2)
A resounding burst of spicy, floral aromatic music. Notes of lychees and roses rustle over a rich bass line to make a great symphony.

19. PETER LEHMANN CHENIN BLANC
Barossa, Australia (12%, 2) 19.95
Fresh and bright with lively sherbet and lime aromas and a floral vivacity. Light and zippy with plenty of apple and pineapple.

20. CLOUDY BAY SAUVIGNON BLANC
Marlborough, New Zealand (13.0%, 2) 34.95
This iconic wine is reminiscent of fresh fruit salad—full of ripe peach, mango, and passion fruit, cut through with a citrus whiplash.

Medium Dry to Medium Sweet

21. WILSON'S QUAY **2.80 3.95 4.95** 13.95
Colombard-Chardonnay, Australia (12.5%, 2)
A smooth easy-drinking medium dry white with a rounded tropical fruit style.

22. LIEBFRAUMILCH FRANZ REH
Rhein, Germany (9.5%, 4) **2.50 3.30 4.50** 12.95
Medium sweet classic from the Rhine. Nice shape and length.
